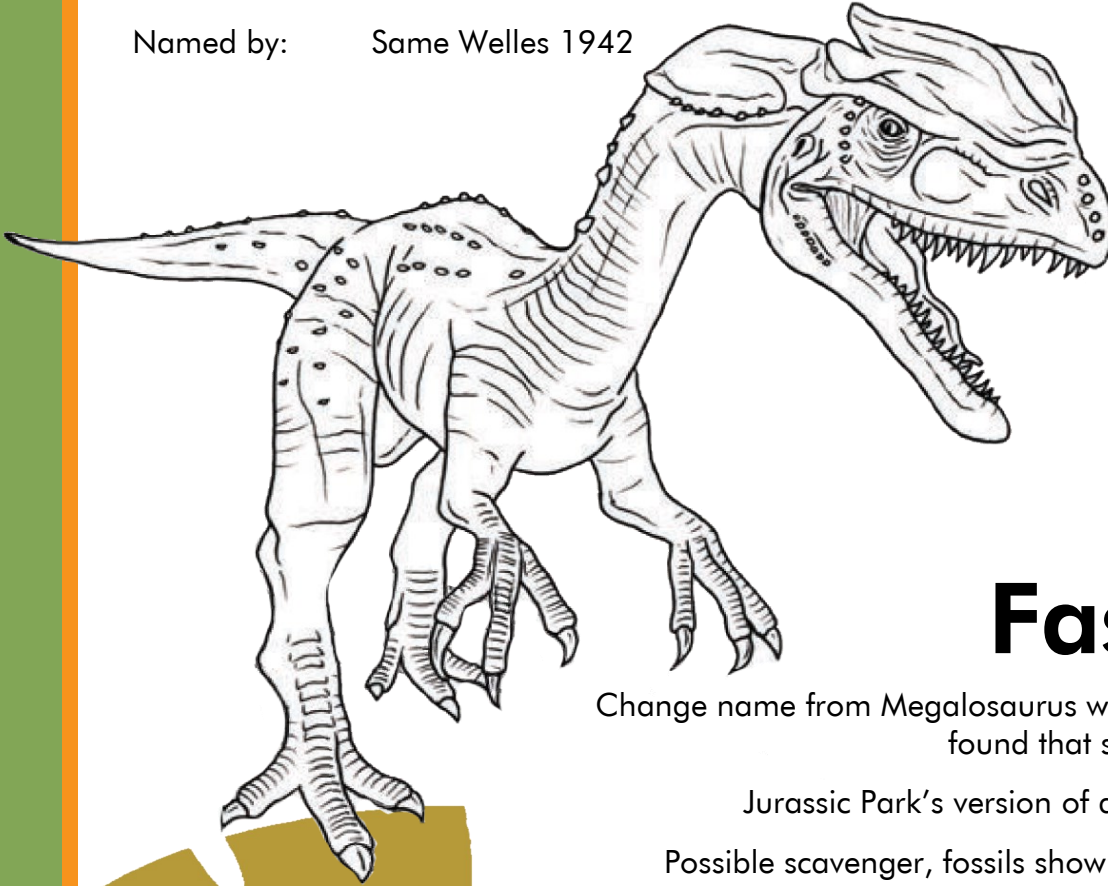


# Dilophosaurus



Pronounced:	Dy-LOF-o-SAWR-as
AKA:	"Two Crested Lizard"
Time period:	Early Jurassic (199-175 million years ago)
Size:	20 ft long, 8 ft tall, 1000lbs
Locomotion:	Bipedal, very fast
Diet:	Carnivore
Location:	US (Arizona, China)
Taxonomy:	<i>Dinosauria, Saurischia, Theropoda, Dilophosauridae</i>
Named by:	Same Welles 1942



## Fast Facts

Change name from Megalosaurus when a second fossil was found that showed the double crest

Jurassic Park's version of dilophosaurs is incorrect

Possible scavenger, fossils show a weak jaw attachment

Jaws were sharp, possibly used for plucking rather than stabbing prey

Most likely did not use it's teeth to kill, would have used claws and feet

Possibly ate small animals
