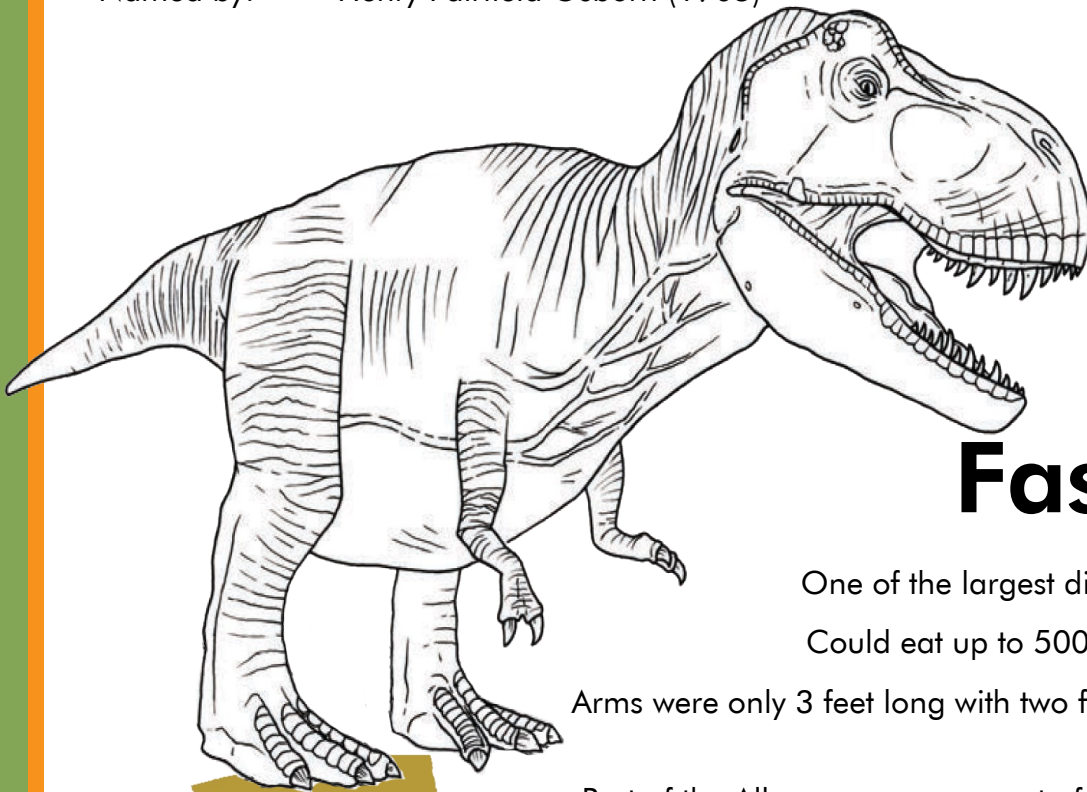


Tyrannosaurus

AKA:	"Tyrant Lizard King"
Time period:	Cretaceous Period (85-65 million years ago)
Size:	40 ft long, 7 tons
Locomotion:	Bipedal
Diet:	Carnivore
Location:	Forests and swamps of North America
Taxonomy:	<i>Saurischia, Theropoda, Tyrannosauridae, Tyrannosaurini</i>
Named by:	Henry Fairfield Osborn (1905)



Fast Facts

One of the largest dinosaurs that ever lived

Could eat up to 500lbs of meat in one bite

Arms were only 3 feet long with two fingers which were very powerful for the size

Part of the Allosaurus group, part of the Carnosaurs ("flesh lizard")

Some experts think T-Rex ate carrion, possibly because wasn't fast/smart enough to hunt

Babies may have had feathers

Female T.Rex were larger than males

Live about 30 years
