JOB TITLE: MAINTENANCE TECHNICIAN

DESCRIPTION: This is manual work in the direction of a work crew engaged in zoo maintenance operations. Answers directly to the Maintenance Supervisor, performing various maintenance and repair operations on zoo grounds, as well as other tasks as required by the Maintenance Supervisor.

1. Considerable knowledge, abilities, and skills of materials, tools and equipment used in area of work assignment.
2. Ability to assign, and inspect the work of a group of workers and to instruct them in proper work methods.
3. Ability to follow oral and written instructions.
4. Must be able to lift and carry 50 pounds or more on a routine basis. Able to drive vehicles: standard and/or automatic.
5. Considerable knowledge of the methods, practices, tools, materials, and equipment used in general construction, repair work and landscape work.
6. Knowledgeable of occupational hazards and necessary safety precautions in the use of equipment and power tools.
7. Ability to plan, organize and supervise all personnel in proper work methods.
8. Also responsible for security of all zoo property, including grounds, buildings, and enclosures.

High school graduate or acceptable equivalent. Considerable experience in area of work preferred. Certification in various areas plus.
